YM Form 3 & 3A	YM Contract and Obligation	A list of rules and obligations the Young Marine agrees to abide by.	09/27/11
YM Form 4	Photo/Video/Film Release	Provides consent to Young Marines to use any and all pictures and/or video of named Young Marine.	09/27/11
YM Med. Form 1	Authorization for Medical Treatment.	Provides consent to Young Marines to seek medical attention for named YM and dispense Over-The-Counter medication.	10/14/11
YM Med. Form 2	Authorization for Medical Treatment	Provides consent to Young Marines to dispense Prescription medication to named YM.	10/14/11
YM Med Form 3	Health History	Provides information on the physical condition of the recruit from a health history the parent or legal guardian completes.	10/14/11
YM Med. Form 4	Physical Examination	. <u>A Physician must complete this form.</u> Recruits can use current school or sports physicals to avoid the expense of an additional physical. Your physician may complete the form from the information already contained in your child's medical history records.
